


MATTHEW-ACTS

- Isaiah 45:3 And I will give you treasures
 hidden in the darkness- secret riches. I will
 do this so you may know that I am the
 LORD, the God of Israel who calls you by
 name.
- God Opened my eyes to:
- -how much I limit him
- -how many healings Jesus did, it is not just what he did, it is who he is (Jehovah Raffa)
- Old covenant (Law) vs. New covenant (Grace) lens
- -the neglected Holy Spirit
- -lies and misguided beliefs I had of God

LAVISHLY LOVED

Ephesians 5:2 TPT And continue to walk surrendered to the extravagant love of Christ, for he surrendered his life as a sacrifice for us. His great love for us was pleasing to God, like an aroma of adoration- a sweet healing fragrance.

- -He is not good to me because I am good but because He is good!
- -The world says we are loved IF, loved BECAUSE, or loved UNTIL. God says you are lavished in love PERIOD.
- Romans 8:15-You did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry Abba! Father!
- -Ephesians I-2 He calls us chosen, Holy, blameless, heirs, lavished with grace, sealed with his Spirit, adopted, Saints, made alive with Christ, saved, seated in heavenly places, his workmanship, brought near, reconciled, dwelling place for the Spirit.
- I John 17 TPT- Love never brings fear, for fear is always related to punishment. But love's perfection drives the fear of punishment far from our hearts.

FULLY FORGIVEN

What covenant am I living from? Old or new?

Romans 8:1-2 There is now NO condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus because through Christ the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death.

- Colossians 2:13-14-You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins. He cancelled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.
- -Romans 5:8- But God demonstrates his love for us in this; While we were still sinners Christ died for us. His love is demonstrated in full forgiveness!
- Hebrews 16a-17-This is the covenant I will make with them...I will remember their sins and lawless deeds no more.
- Romans 2:4 God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance (renewed mind)
- -It is FINISHED!
- Story of the prodigal son- the father runs to him and embraces BEFORE any apology takes place.
- Seeing God not as displeased father waiting for perfectly crafted apology, but seeing myself as Fully forgiven because of Christ's finished work!

RADICALLY RIGHTEOUS

Romans 5:1 TPT- Our faith in Jesus now transfers God's righteousness to us and He now declares us flawless in his eyes.

- Romans 5:19 For just as through the disobedience of one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of one man the many will be made righteous.
- -2 Corinthians 5:21- God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
- -Ephesians 4:24- ...to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.
- Isaiah 61:10 I delight greatly in the Lord; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and covered me in a robe of his righteousness.
- Story of Prodigal son- the forgiven son is the one wearing the robe, not the son trusting in his own works!

THE HOLY SPIRIT

In Scripture He is called: Breath, comforter, counselor, helper, revealer of Truth, God's power, advocate, intercessor, strengthener. Scripture says He never leaves us, we are sealed with Him, he is a person, He is equal to God and Jesus, He is our guarantee, he gave power to the disciples and to us, he communicates, he is a friend, he gives spiritual gifts, he baptizes, he produces fruit, he makes us more like Jesus.

- John 16:7- I tell you the truth, It is better for you that I go away. If I do not go, the Helper will not come to you. If I go, I will send Him to you.
- Acts I:8 But you will (continually in Hebrew)
 receive power when the Holy spirit comes on
 you...
- Luke 11:11- If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give (continually in Hebrew) the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!
- Acts 4:29-31 (Peter and John praying)..."Enable your servants to speak your work with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders in the name of your Holy servant Jesus". After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
- -Just ASK!



INSIGHTS

The Spirit of the sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor, to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness the prisoners. Isaiah 61: I I, the Lord have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand, to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from bondage and release from prison those who sit in darkness. Isaiah 42:6-7

- Jesus is still doing miracles, we can ask with boldness.
- Spirit power is always better than self sufficiency.
- Jesus was always pointing to the Kingdom come, on earth as it is in heaven. He was not just proving he was the Son with his miracles and ministry, he was bringing heaven to earth.
- Embrace risk and step in faith in asking God to show up in ways only he can. He holds the outcome and it is always for our good and his glory. He would have still been good if his answer was no.
- Remember who we are: Lavishly loved, fully forgiven, radically righteous, indwelt with the Holy Spirit as our constant companion and helper.
- Spiritual sight is always better than physical sight. The enemy wants to keep us focused on our overwhelming circumstances not on how God is working in all things.
